## Chris Przemieniecki

Assistant Professor of Criminology and Law Enforcement at Montgomery County Community College in Pennsylvania, Chris Przemieniecki has been researching street gangs for more than 15 years. He specializes in how street gangs are portrayed in mass media (*movies, music, video games, popular books and magazines, the internet*), and is a popular presenter at national conferences, a published author, and a certified gang specialist/consultant.
